Environmental Policy

Falck Renewables operates in the wind energy sector, generating electricity from a renewable source. We recognise that some aspects of our business, which includes development and construction, have impacts on the environment which can be negative as well as positive. We recognise the importance of environmental protection, social awareness and the conservation of natural resources and are committed to the prevention of pollution and the continual improvement of our environmental performance.

Objectives

We aim to achieve best practice in our business activities by:

- ◆ Conducting our operations so as to prevent pollution, maximise operational efficiency, conserve natural resources, minimise the impact and quantity of waste and operate with regard to local circumstances.
- ◆ Complying with all relevant environmental legislation and agreements.
- ◆ Promoting awareness of environmental and sustainability issues amongst our staff, customers and suppliers. Providing training and education to encourage a culture of continual improvement.
- ◆ Communicating openly with all interested parties about our environmental policy, plans and performance, unless prevented by commercial constraints, confidentiality or personal rights.
- ◆ Seeking opportunities to have a positive influence on the business practices of suppliers and other stakeholders.
- ◆ Following a programme designed to deliver continual improvement, through specific objectives and targets based on this policy.

Management Responsibilities

Where Joint Venture Projects or use of sub contracted staff are concerned, the Managing Director, Directors and their management teams will seek to ensure that:

- ◆ The company uses its influence so far as possible to ensure that appropriate environmental practices are put into place.
