FALCK RENEWABLES COMPLETES THE ACQUISITION OF 5 WIND FARMS IN FRANCE

Milan, March 15, 2019 – Falck Renewables S.p.A., through its subsidiary Falck Energies Renouvelables SAS, announces today the closing for the acquisition, from Glennmont Clean Energy Coöperatief U.A., of 100% stake of a portfolio of 5 operational wind farms in France, as announced on December 6, 2018. The price for the acquisition of the portfolio is about Euro 36.9 million, financed entirely with own resources.

The portfolio consists of 25 turbines for a total export capacity of 56* MW and an expected annual total output of 117 GWh.

The deal will allow Falck Renewables to reinforce its presence in France, realize synergies with its other French operating assets and create a significant growth in the country.

Falck Renewables S.p.A., listed on the Italian stock exchange in the STAR segment (“FKR.MI”) and included in the FTSE Italia Mid Cap Index, develops, designs, builds and manages power production plants from renewable sources, with an installed capacity of 970 MW in 2018 (933.5 MW according to the IFRS 11 reclassification) in the United Kingdom, Italy, United States, Spain and France, using wind power, solar power, WtE and biomass technologies. The Group is a global player in the renewable energy technical advisory and asset management services business, through its wholly owned subsidiary Vector Cuatro, providing asset management services to clients accounting for approximately 2400 MW of installed capacity and with experience in more than 30 countries.
