Falck Group's appeals granted: trials before Court of Milan to continue

Milan, 29 May 2013. Following the press releases of 28 August 2012 and 22 May 2013, it is hereby announced that, by decision notified yesterday, the United Sections of Italy's Supreme Court have granted the appeals filed by Group companies on 23 September 2012 against the orders whereby the Court of Milan had suspended the proceedings pending the resolution of the trials before the Regional Administrative Court of Sicily.

In further detail, Italy's Supreme Court quashed the aforementioned orders suspending the proceedings started by the Falck Group's companies against the Sicilian Regional Administration, establishing that the trials are to continue before the Court of Milan.

The Company welcomes the decision of the Supreme Court and confirms that, despite having acted in write-off and adjustments to the financial statements relating to Sicilian projects, as announced on 22 May 2013, will continue the litigations against the Sicilian Region in order to protect the reasons and rights of the Group.
