Falck Renewables S.p.A. reaches 731 MW of total installed capacity, 288 MW of which in the UK

The company confirms its commitment in the UK with the completion of Nutberry Wind Farm and the authorization obtained for the Assel Valley wind farm in Scotland

Milan, 21 October 2013 - Falck Renewables SpA announces that it has reached 731 MW of total installed capacity, 288 of which in the UK.

The Company has recently put into operation Nutberry wind farm. Located near Nutberry Hill in Scotland, the park consists of 6 Nordex wind turbines with an installed capacity of 15 MW and will generate about 54 GWh/year of renewable energy to meet the energy need of 12,500 households with a CO2 saving of about 23,000 tons / year.

The full commissioning is expected for the end of November.

Falck Renewables SpA has also obtained the authorization to start the construction of Assel Valley wind farm, located near Girvan in the south west of Scotland. The wind farm will have ten turbines and an installed capacity of up to a maximum of 30 MW.

Piero Manzoni, CEO of Falck Renewables, commented: "With the launch of Nutberry wind farm and the authorization of Assel Valley, our growth path continues, as well as our positioning among the leading pure player in the renewable energy sector in the UK, in line with the Business Plan. The pipeline of projects we are implementing envisages, between the end of 2013 and 2015, a further increase of our presence in the Country in various technologies and responds to the diversification strategy aiming to seize the best opportunities at international level"

Falck Renewables S.p.A., a member of the Falck Group listed on the Stock Exchange (ticker: FKR), operates in Europe with some 731 MW installed capacity, and develops, designs, builds and manages plants for the production of energy from renewable sources.
